Subject : Recruitment of Paramedical Staff on regular basis.

Respected Sir,

In the last R&P meeting held in Chennai on 23rd Feb. '2013. The issue of recruiting regular Pharmacists was discussed, and it was brought to the notice of the house that, in reference to the advertisement 3 yrs. diploma in pharmacy does not exists in our education system.


It was agreed that the same will be reviewed and vacancy will be refloated as per the qualification defined by statutory body i.e. "Pharmacy Council of India", it was also requested to give age relaxation to the Paramedics who are engaged in various regions directly by ONGC without involving a contractor, this was principally agreed. The decision taken to regularize all nursing staff by giving age relaxation in Assam is highly appreciated, all other paramedic equally placed are desperately waiting to get an equal opportunity.

Even after a lapse of 1 year 3 months the vacancies with the above agreed conditions are yet to be floated for regular posts. Where as we find that presently once again the same contractual procedure of recruitment is advertized in western region, with upper age limits, this will bar the paramedics who are engaged for more than 15-20 yrs to apply against the said vacancies.

We are enclosing list of paramedical staff who are working in Hazira Plant as well as the nature of job they are performing.

It is earnestly requested that as agreed in the said R&P meeting in Chennai, regular vacancies for paramedics may please be floated at the earliest and the existing contractual procedures be dispensed with.


