Attention of the parties are invited of their obligations imposed under the provisions of Section 22, 23 and 33 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 and request strict compliance of the same during the pendency of Conciliation Proceedings. A copy of the notice dated 11.11.2020 is enclosed for ready reference. The employer / management is advised to submit their written statement on all the issues on the date of conciliation proceedings.

All Parties are requested to wear mask, maintain social distance and one representative will be allowed during the conciliation proceedings.
