**Subject:- To generate QR Code based pass to travel by train for  
Mumbai - Uran 'ONGC Employee' commuters.**

Respected sir,

I wish to bring your kind attention on the employee travelling from Mumbai area to Uran will require authorisation by ONGC to travel by Local trains as Railway had issued an order that without authorisation of concern 'Essential Service' provider Organization its employee will not able to travel by train.

ONGC have to appoint a coordinator who will feed data related to ONGC employee on Government website <https://epassmsdma.mahait.org> and SMS will be sent to an employee to generate QR Code based pass to travel by train.

Advisory issued by the Government of Maharashtra

Key Details Regarding the QR Code-based Travel Pass:-

- The new QR code-based pass will allow Mumbaikars to travel according to various levels divided into five categories. The step will allow the civic body to control crowding amid the corona virus pandemic.
- With the new system, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) will be able to keep track of people travelling in the local trains based on the level of restrictions imposed. For instance, a traveller with a Degree 3 pass will be permitted to travel if the level of restrictions in effect is 1, 2, or 3. A bearer of Degree 2 pass will be able to travel only if the level of limitations is 1 or 2.

- Meanwhile, a Degree 5 pass holder will be able to access the local trains regardless of the level of restrictions.
- The new QR-code-based ticketing system will be checked at the railway stations in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR) with the help of a smartphone or QR code reader.
- Anyone found travelling without the authentic QR code will be fined Rs. 500/- on the spot.
