Subject : Treating Diploma in Pharmacy as Q2 for career growth in ONGC.

Respected Sir,

This is in reference to our letter dated 3.04.2006 vide No. ONGC/KS/118/2006 on the above issue. Please find copy attached for your perusal.

Further in reference to the circular dated 17th July 2007 vide No. DDN/R&P/25(11)/2000 (Pt) reading competent authorities consideration to treat Diploma in Pharmacy after 10th standard (SSLC) followed by 12th standard as Q2 in Pharmacy discipline w. e. from 01.01.2000, also quotes that existing employees of ONGC on or before 31.12.1996 would get the coverage of above benefit.

The second part of the circular i. e. extending the benefit to existing employees who have joined on or before 31.12.1996, while appreciating the above consideration, we wish your authority to erase the impreciseness of the circular, by elaborating whether the existing employees with 10th standard (SSLC) + Diploma in Pharmacy will be beneficiary also or not, as we had represented through our above letter that existing employees with 10 + Diploma in Pharmacy be treated as Q2 for their future career growth in Pharmacy discipline.

In our above mentioned letter we have elaborated the changes put to effect by Pharmacy Council of India also the details of the course. From the seniority list it can be seen that it's a very small group and only around 15 Pharmacists are not benefiting by the deviation caused by including 12th standard as qualification criteria.


