


**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

The undersigned is directed to say that the holiday on account of Id-ul-Zuha (Bakrid) was notified for 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2026, in the list of holidays for the year 2026 circulated vide this Ministry's O.M.No.12/2/2023-JCA dated 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2025, subject to change in date, depending on the sighting of the moon. It has now been brought to the notice of this Ministry that, in Delhi, Id-ul-Zuha (Bakrid) will be celebrated on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

2. Accordingly, it has been decided to shift the holiday on account of Id-ul- Zuha (Bakrid) to 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 in place of 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 as notified earlier, for all Central Government administrative offices in Delhi/New Delhi.
